Policy on the use of AI Tools

The use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools (e.g., ChatGPT, Grammarly, image generators, code assistants) is permitted **only under the following conditions**:

Acceptable Use

- All may be used as a **support tool** for brainstorming, outlining, grammar checking, or concept clarification.
- Students must **review, edit, and understand** any AI-assisted content before submission.
- Any use of AI must be **clearly disclosed** in the activity/assessment (e.g., in a short note at the end or in a footnote)
- Al should be treated as a **learning aid**, not a replacement for original thought.

Unacceptable Use

- Submitting Al-generated work without disclosure.
- Using AI to **complete entire activities or assessments** without permission.
- Relying on AI to produce content that bypasses understanding or independent learning.
- Using AI to create responses for **personal reflections**, **creative tasks**, **or evaluative writing** unless explicitly allowed.

Consequences

Misuse of AI tools may be treated as a **violation of integrity,** and participants may be required to redo the activity or assessment. If participants continue to misuse AI tools, the training agency has the right to remove a participant for the course/training and no refund will be issued.

When in Doubt

Participants are encouraged to **ask the trainer** before using AI for any part of an activity or assessment if they are unsure whether it falls within acceptable use.
